THE ABOVE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **SERVICES PROVIDED:** Guide will provide Client with: LODGING (tents), FOOD, GUIDING, NATURE INTERPRETATION, CANOE TRANSPORT, ITEMS SET OUT IN 4(d) BELOW and RETURN MOTOR VEHICLE TRANSPORTATION FROM WHITEHORSE TO TRAIL HEAD OR RIVER PUT IN only on the trip and dates herein specified. Client is responsible for transportation to Whitehorse and other items not specifically the responsibility of the Guide herein.
2. **TRIP TYPE:** RIVER/LAKE: _____ **NUMBER OF DAYS:** _____

3. **FEES:** For trip described herein, Client agrees to pay Guide, IN CANADIAN FUNDS, or equivalent, a total of \$ _____ in two instalments:
 - (a) INITIAL PAYMENT \$250.00 non-refundable deposit due at the time of reservation
 - (b) FINAL PAYMENT Balance of \$ _____ due on or before 60 days before commencement date of trip
4. **TERMS (read all terms completely):**
 - (a) ALL TRIP PAYMENTS TO GUIDE REQUIRED IN BANK DRAFTS DRAWN ON A CANADIAN OR U.S. BANK OR BY CHEQUE. FINAL PAYMENTS MUST BE PAID AT LEAST 60 DAYS IN ADVANCE OF COMMENCEMENT OF TRIP.
 - (b) **CANCELLATION:** In the event the trip is cancelled prior to 60 days before the commencement date of the trip, the initial payment will be non-refundable. In the event the trip is cancelled within 60 days of the commencement date of the trip, 50% of the initial and final payments will be non-refundable. All non-refundable amounts may be applicable to a replacement trip, satisfactory to Guide, less any costs incurred by Guide as a result of the cancellation.
 - (c) **TRANSPORTATION COSTS:** GUIDE FEE DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY COST OF ANY TRANSPORTATION FOR CLIENT OR HIS BELONGINGS TO AND FROM WHITEHORSE. All costs of such transportation are Client's responsibility, including emergency medivacs. Once at Whitehorse price includes return transport from Whitehorse required to move or support Client during the scheduled trip period. Client is responsible for providing all outdoor clothing and day equipment (please see attached Personal List for recommended items to bring).
 - (d) **ITEMS PROVIDED BY GUIDE:** Guide will provide all food, canoes and related equipment, fishing equipment, sleeping mats, tents, general camp equipment (other than items set out in 4(c) above and attached Personal List).
 - (e) **NO OTHER REPRESENTATIONS:** Except as specifically provided in this agreement there are no other implied warrants or other warranties, statements, conditions, guarantees, representations, or other agreements with respect to the guiding services to be furnished.
 - (f) **INSURANCE:** Client agrees that it is the Client and his party members (and not the Guide) who are responsible for all expenses and damages arising out of injury, sickness or death during and to and from the trip, including all medical expenses (including doctor's fees, hospital and other institutional costs, medication and medivac flights) and lost income and death benefits and trip cancellation costs. To cover all such expenses and damages, the Client agrees to purchase and have in force adequate insurance policies for himself and his party members. Similarly, the Client and his party members are responsible for all loss or damages of their own property and the Client agrees to purchase and have in force adequate insurance policies for himself and his party members to cover such loss and damages.
